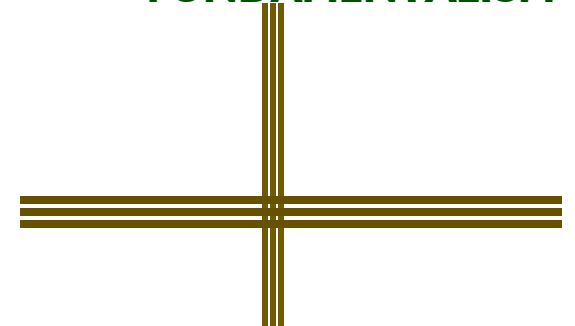
-What sort of instruction should we be offering folks new to Lutheranism?

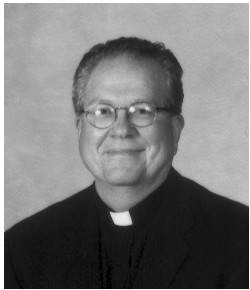
